- * THE FEAST OF THE INCARNATION better known as Christmas commemorates an event that would change the world
- * Luke 2: 11 "For there is born to you this day in the city of David a Savior, who is Christ the Lord."
- * Over the last two weeks we considered "The Timing of the Message" and "The Theme of the Message" ... "when the fullness of time had come, God sent forth His Son ... to redeem those who were under the law"
- Today, we want to consider "The Subject of the Message" Who was born the birth of Christ, the Lord!

- * Christ (χριστος) an anointed one; one who was consecrated for a special task (O.T.: priests, kings, prophets)
- * Lord (Kupios) can refer either to "Master" or "YHWH" (cf. Matthew 22: 42-45)

* Isaiah 46:9 He is the Only God (cf. 44:8; 45:5-6; 45:22)

* Isaiah 42:8 I am YHWH that is My Name ; and My glory I will not give to another - cf. John 1: 14; John 20:27-29; Rev 4: 8-11; Rev 5:9-13
* Isaiah 43:10-13 He is the Savior (Cf. Titus 1: 3-4; 2: 13; John 10:27-29)
* Isaiah 45: 22-23 (cf. Philippians 2: 11)
* Isaiah 48: 12-16 the tri-unity of the godhead
b. In The New Testament (cf. Romans 9: 3-5; Philippians 2: 5-8; Colossians 2:6-10)
