- * Our final consideration is the Desires of God or, as in commonly stated, "The Will of God"
- * In review, the exercise of one's will is directly proportional to the determination of one's desires.
- * Each time that we make a decision, which is seen as the expression of our will, we are revealing the priority of our desires
- ⁴ God's "Will" is the expression of His desires which are consistent with His being, composition, plan, and attributes.
