INTRODUCTION

- * God's plan for Christ to come into the world was not a mystery. He had planned it before the foundations of the world were laid.
- * Acceptance of the provision of Christ is a matter of faith based upon the foundation and testimony of Scripture.
- * In fact, in John 20:29 we read Jesus stating to Thomas,

"because you have seen Me, you have believed. Blessed are those who have not seen and yet have believed."

- So far, we have considered that the Messiah would be YHWH, incarnate as man, our living redeemer, the seed of Abraham and fulfill the role of High Priest in the order of Melchizedek.
