- * Matthew 6:19-24 ¹⁹ "<u>Do not lay up for yourselves treasures on earth</u>, where moth and rust destroy and where thieves break in and steal; ²⁰ <u>but lay up for yourselves treasures (thesauros) in heaven</u>, where neither moth nor rust destroys and where thieves do not break in and steal. ²¹ For <u>where your treasure (thesauros) is, there your heart will be also.</u> ²² The lamp of the body is the eye. If therefore your eye is good, your whole body will be full of light. ²³ But if your eye is bad, your whole body will be full of darkness. If therefore the light that is in you is darkness, how great is that darkness! ²⁴ No one can serve two masters; for either he will hate the one and love the other, or else he will be loyal to the one and despise the other. <u>You cannot serve God and mammon</u>."
